The Wells for Sudan Golf tournament is an extension of the “Jacob’s Well” project and will provide resources for additional wells. This will be a unique event in that individuals and churches have underwritten all expenses for the

tournament. Every dollar given for team fees and “hole sponsors” will go for wells in Sudan. The team fees alone could raise as much \$14,000 with a full field of 140 golfers. The “hole sponsors” are a suggested \$100 donation. These will come from churches, Sunday school classes, small groups, individuals and businesses. If 200 holes were funded, that would mean an additional \$20,000 amounting to a total of \$34,000 for wells, which would cover the cost of three wells. Luke 1:37 teaches us all things are possible with God. This amount and more is possible with God.

The children and people of Sudan are waiting for the “living water” these wells represent. It is the hope of the Jacob’s Well Project that many wells will be realized on May 27, 2010. Bishop James Swanson is the tournament host. Golfers and “non-golfers” alike are invited to help make this hope come to pass. A Jacob’s Well Project

“Jacob’s Well” became a reality in August 2009 when the Kingsley Hermon Circuit heard a stirring message of the plight of the people of Sudan delivered by Beth Tipton; student minister at UVa Wise. The pastor of the charge had a dream given to him by God at Annual Conference in June 2009 when the offering amount for Sudan was announced. The dream was that the two point charge he was about to receive could raise \$10,000 for a well. That pastor had no idea that one of the churches was struggling financially at that time. After that service in August, the pastor received affirmation that God would provide for a well when a 12-year-old young man handed the pastor \$20 and said, “I would like to be the first person to give money for the well.” That young man’s name is Jacob and that \$20 was part of his birthday money. The Mission Committee thought it only fitting that the project be called “Jacob’s Well.” With God leading, the Kingsley Hermon Circuit is on track to exceed their goal of providing a well by May 2010.
