WORKSHOP DESCRIPTIONS	
The Grand Adventure: Second Half of Life – Part 1 – Linda Douty (9:30 only)	This workshop will focus on issues of discovering the authentic self that God created you to be, finding ways to use your gifts and talents, and how to live a thankful life.
The Grand Adventure: Second Half of Life – Part 2 – Linda Douty (10:45 only)	This workshop will focus on issues of dealing with loneliness, bodily challenges, forgiveness, and living life with hope and faith.
Healing Oils of the Bible – Jamie Hyatt (9:30 and 10:45)	Participants will experience and learn how pure essential oils were used throughout the Bible for anointing and healing and how these same oils can be used today. Bring your Bible to look up specific verse references.
Bible Study: A Storyteller's Look at the Gospel of John – Rev. Charles Maynard (9:30 and 10:45)	Come to study John's gospel through the lens of a storyteller. John tells Jesus' story in a marvelous way. This study will look at Jesus' life as THE story as told by John.
Caution: Hilarity May Lead to Health and Happiness – Judy Whedbee (9:30 and 10:45)	Studies have shown that humor can lead to better health and increased happiness. Come to this session and discover how a good laugh can have positive physical, emotional, and social benefits. Find ways that humor can help in dealing with anger, embarrassment, guilt, and stress.
